RCU Bylaw Update & Modernization

At our upcoming April RCU annual meeting our Board of Directors will be bringing forward an update to our bylaws. Our primary goal is to prepare for any future annual meetings and elections in the event we are unable to be together for an in-person meeting. We are also adding provisions to assure we continue to move forward with no volunteer or staff conflicts of interest. For volunteers it will only be allowable to have one person from any one immediate family serving at the same time. For employees there will be a two year pause after completing their employment service before they are eligible to run for office. We are also clarifying that you need to be of legal age, eighteen, in order to run for, hold office, or vote in our elections. Finally, we are expanding our field of membership to include the volunteers and members of the ND State Railroad Museum (Mandan, ND), an entity we have long had close connections with.

A full draft of the changes is available upon request from any office and will be available at the annual meeting.
